In this issue we address one of the most common and justifiable questions about our project – “What are the benefits?” From our perspective the answers are many, and they are about much more than just dollars and cents.

Economic Benefits:

- Starting employment of 5 to 10 positions growing up to 25 when the project reaches full production;
- Competitive wages and salaries within Yavapai County;
- Fuel purchases of 50,000 to 500,000 gallons per year, adding to the state's Highway User Revenue Fund through fuel taxes;
- Sales tax base from the purchase of equipment, parts, supplies, and services;
- Property taxes on the private land held by KMC and additional revenue opportunities through the State Transaction Privilege Tax;
- KMC's commitment to explore opportunities to give back to the communities through education and future employment.
- KMC's commitment to work with local business, government and community leaders to be a part of planning for other future community economic development and infrastructure.

Social Benefits:

- Explore opportunities to work with local communities and partner with KMC to find the best ways to enhance schools, local fire departments, and local businesses.
- Explore options for creative post-reclamation uses of the land including recreation, grazing, and wildlife habitat.

Environmental Benefits:

- Extending dwindling fly ash supplies and displacing the production of millions of tons of Portland cement, thereby displacing millions of tons of CO₂.
- Producing significantly more durable concrete, extending its life and reducing the energy-intensive process of removing and replacing the world's most widely used building material.
